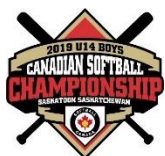


# Champ's Chatter

The pitching was strong on both sides. Grey Dodgers pitchers struck out ten, while Thunder pitchers sat down eight. **Dakota McComb** got the win for ON2 Chatsworth. He went four innings, allowing zero runs on three hits and striking out seven. **Sean Demarest** took the loss for Wilmot Thunder He surrendered one run on two hits over two innings, striking out three and walking one.

The West Grey Dodgers got things moving in the first inning. Ronnenberg drove in two when he singled. New Hamberg evened things up at two in the top of the third inning when **Fisher Ward** hit a solo homer.

**Cohen Christner** started the game for New Hamberg. He lasted four innings, allowing three hits and two runs while striking out five. **Joseph Weiler** started the game for Chatsworth allowing three hits and two runs over three innings and striking out three.
